This position is responsible for overseeing the club mini program (U4, U6, U8). With emphasis on youth player development and fun during training sessions. The Technical Director is responsible for developing and implementing sound weekly training sessions and assisting, mentoring and instructing volunteer coaches in delivering station based training. The Technical Director will work closely with, and report to the CC Riders Director of Soccer.

The Technical Director will be responsible for providing technical development for players and coaches in the CC Riders mini program. Job responsibilities will include, but not be limited to the technical coordination, planning and implementation required to oversee a grassroots program.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop and provide weekly training programs for U4, U6, U8 boys and girls
- Recruit, develop and manage volunteer coaches in mini program
- Develop and maintain an online resource library for coaches to access
- Organize monthly jamborees throughout the summer season for U8
- Provide monthly technical reports to the Director of Soccer
- Assist to establish and manage the club technical budget
